By JULY 1st - Artists will be notified of their acceptance.

Artist Registration fee of \$50 (per artist) will be due by August 1st.

ARTIST COMMISSION:

A **20% commission** will be deducted from Artists' net sales. The commission proceeds will benefit The Foundation for Tigard Tualatin Schools. These specific proceeds will be distributed to all 15 Tigard Tualatin schools (elementary through high school) to be used in the Performing & Fine Arts programs. FTTS is a non-profit organization and artists will receive the appropriate documentation for tax purposes (charitable contribution).

SHOW SET-UP INFO:

Booth Size: Approximately 8' x 8'. Height limit – 9' *please note booth size may vary based on location.

Electricity: We have **limited** amount of booth space with access to electricity. Booths having such will be awarded based on date application received. Availability will be communicated upon show acceptance.

Donated Art: Upon show check in we will gladly accept a donated piece of your art with **100% of the proceeds** benefiting Art in the Burbs. We will provide special tags and a designated display area for donated pieces at the show.

Your Display Tables must be provided by ALL artists. Art in the Burbs cannot supply any type of display tables. We do provide chairs for the booth but you are welcome to bring your own chair. It is required that any tables used for display purposes be covered with a clean, ironed, floor length table draping (solid color). Please bring a biography, newspaper coverage or personal information to enhance your display. Shoppers love that kind of information!!

Hanging Art: Please provide panels for hanging framed artwork. Please do not use easels due to the amount of space they require.

Artist Attendance: We encourage all artists to be present throughout the show, or have an attendant present in your booth.. Our Event Sales history shows a strong correlation between artists attendance and high sales volume.

Our Website: Once accepted you will be asked to provide 1 electronic image and information to be included on our Burbs website. Deadline for this information will be August 1, 2011 (same as Registration fee).

FOOD:

Food and beverages will be available for purchase in our Burbs Bistro.

CENTRAL CHECK-OUT:

All purchases will be made through our central check-out area. No exceptions.
